\_\_03. Overall, would you say that things in the country are generally headed in the right direction, or, have things pretty seriously gotten off on the wrong track?

- 52% | Wrong track
- 36% | Right direction
- 12% | Undecided/Refused

\_\_04. How about in Michigan -- would you say that things in Michigan are generally headed in the right direction, or, have things pretty seriously gotten off on the wrong track?

- 44% | Right direction
- 33% | Wrong track
- 23% | Undecided/Refused

12%	Somewhat supports Tea Party movement
